Speakers may be called in the order that requests are received or grouped by subject area. Comments are limited to 2 minutes each so that as many people as possible may be heard. The Board will strive to limit the total agenda time for public comments to 15 minutes. By law, the Board is allowed to take action only on items on the agenda. The Board or staff may not get involved in discussions about an issue that is not on the agenda. A Board Member may ask a brief question for clarification, make a brief announcement, or provide a reference to staff or other sources for factual information. The Board may, at its discretion, refer a matter to staff or ask staff to place a topic on a future agenda.
